

How did Dogmatic come to be? The short answer is 'Necessity is the Mother of Invention'!

It is difficult to know where to start as it is something that has evolved completely by chance and out of necessity rather than some grand scheme.

Susan Lewsley, my Mum and the designer of the Dogmatic, has had back/leg and neck pain for 28 years due to disc/nerve problems and arthritis resulting in seven major back operations and two major neck operations plus arthritis in her hands.

This meant she could no longer walk or even hold our dogs let alone be involved in showing them. We had Dobermanns for 26 years (including Tommy, Top Dobermann in the UK 2000) and enjoyed showing same. We were using the known makes of Headcollars but found, not only did they not stop them pulling, they were all rubbing and riding up into our dogs' eyes and they had even managed to get them off. We found neither the Headcollars or harnesses were taking the strength or weight of the dogs and, in fact, the dogs were putting their weight against the harnesses thus making them even harder to hold on to with some makes rubbing them raw!

Mum's problems were being aggravated by trying to cope with our three Dobermanns and walking, showing or even holding them was no longer viable. Rather than give up, she decided to experiment with a Headcollar that would work by turning the dog's head in a kindly manner which would ensure the body would have to follow, yet was comfortable to wear and would stop your dog pulling and lunging.

We had a local saddler help with prototypes/samples etc., Many ideas/styles were tried and tested until we were happy with the finished product.

The Headcollar evolved into the present design and the finished product not only is comfy but does not ride up or go near the dog's eyes. It works on all breeds/sizes of dog and ensures your dog will immediately follow where you want to lead. An extra bonus is that, in an emergency, the Dogmatic can be used to close the dog's mouth and turn it's head to enable the owner to keep their dog safe but immediately releases again allowing the dog to pant, drink, carry a toy etc., It is very comfortable for the dog to wear and offers complete control for the owner. We have even been able to help other disabled owners with their dogs and also dogs in rescue who were previously untrainable and, therefore, unable to be rehomed.

We had three black leather Headcollars with brass fittings made for our dogs and this meant Mum and I could now walk the dogs together and she could hold them when I was in the ring etc., This was a major lifestyle change.

The name Dogmatic and the strapline (Automatically Leading the Way) literally came to Mum in the middle of the night and she jotted them down on a pad by the side of the bed together with a few less desirable ones before going back to sleep!



We started using the Headcollars on our dogs and were astounded at peoples' response. We literally kept getting stopped wherever we went, be it in the field, training, walks, Shows, at the Vet etc., etc., People would ask if we could make them one for their dog and so it began!

We realised we would have to learn about sizings and how to fit all the different breeds. Neither of us are natural sales people or over-confident by nature so it was interesting to have to approach people to ask if we could measure their dogs and trial our sizing samples on as many breeds and cross-breeds as possible. Fortunately, most dog owners are a very friendly lot and everybody was very helpful and eager for their dogs to be included in the research!

We were having them made individually at the Saddlery to begin with and then as word of mouth spread we found a small Independent Leather Manufacturer in Birmingham. They were so helpful and allowed us to order in small quantities. They also helped with leads Mum designed, in particular specialised non-slip leads which give you much more grip on the lead – again designed through our own need which is a whole different story!

I was still working at Reading University as Post Graduate Admissions Co-Ordinator — I have worked as Customer Services Manager and in Admin Officer roles, whilst Mum is a fully qualified Secretary/PA - and I was fulfilling orders part-time. We were on a huge learning curve and had to get advice/help very quickly. Mum was in and out of hospital and I realised I would have to go part-time at work if we were to take a gamble and 'go for it' on a small budget and a prayer!

Our name started to grow through small adverts and 'word of mouth'. We needed to expand and found a larger Equestrian Leather Manufacturer, organised packaging, labelling, printing etc., and gradually we grew to such a degree I had to go full time in 2001.

We have slowly built up Dogmatic and the Headcollar, Collars and Leads are now in Shops, Vets, on Trade Stands, being used by Police, Prison Officers, Rescues, Behaviourists, Trainers, Clubs etc., as well as individual dog owners. We try to help small Businesses, Clubs, Rescues etc., by offering low minimum orders at trade prices so any profits can go back into them. Dogmatic is also endorsed by famous dog Behaviourist Dr David Sands and recommended as his Headcollar of choice in his books.

Over the years we lost our Dobermanns but had fallen in love with the Italian Spinone and now had Kofi who became our new mascot and model for the Dogmatic.

We have gone on learning and expanding and we now also have a range of Headcollars, Collars and Leads in Padded Cushioned Webbing which are vibrant in different colours. We have a specialised Training range in top quality Lined Leather available in black and brown with brass fittings.

We have designed our own packaging and branding and it is amaz<mark>ing to see the boys' photos on the</mark> packaging on the stands at the Shows and Crufts etc.,!

We have recently lost Kofi at the age of 12 years, but we have his son Archie and Archie's son Norman and they are all our models and attend pet Trade Fairs with us and we all have a marvellous time but it is getting more and more difficult for my Mum to cope with same. The Fairs are very succ<mark>essful and the dogs love all the</mark> attention they receive! In fact we could have sold them ten times over!!

We supply a growing number of Shops, Vets, Groomers, Trainers, Behaviourists etc., and the more we can get the Dogmatic out there for the general public to see and try on their dogs, the easier their dog walking will be! As you can see we have a large amount of customer feedback —where the Dogmatic has lite<mark>rally changed their lives and</mark> meant they can walk their dogs without having their arms pulled out of their sockets! We have a Facebook page and Twitter Account and a large number of photos and videos from satisfied dog owners.



Tribute to Kofi

Kofi – Montecani Moon Storm at Estover 6th March 2003 – 20th May 2015



Well, what can we say about Kofi, he came into our lives at 7 weeks, a little bundle of whiskers and moustache, looking like a studious old man. Little did we know just how special and unique he would be!

We had waited for some time for his arrival and he immediately fitted in to our home, strutting around with such a happy, playful disposition.

It is with great sadness that we lost our big beautiful Gent, Kofi. The 'face' of Dogmatic for his 12 years, Kofi has always been a wonderful, gentleman, who has filled our lives from the moment we brought him home.

We nearly lost Kofi at 6 months – he had attended his first Show and won Best Puppy but later that evening he became extremely poorly and was rushed to the Vets. It later transpired he had caught Campylobacter and was desperately ill. He lost 10kgs in three days and we were told to expect the worst. One of the Vets advised we could try 'Interferon' which may help him but as it was

the Friday evening of a Bank Holiday, they couldn't order any in until Tuesday and he probably wouldn't make it. We asked if we could get it elsewhere and she advised she was off duty now and 'it depends how hard you want to try'! Needless to say, we travelled surrounding counties each day to buy enough for him (and will forever be indebted to the help from The Dog's Trust for their generous donation of the drug) and, eventually, after much worry and hard work, he recovered.

So I suppose, anything after then was a bonus!

Kofi far exceeded our expectations both as a Show dog -Winning at Crufts, Winning his Challenge Certificate at Leeds Championship Show, passing on his qualities and temperament to his Son and Grand Son and producing CC and RCC progeny but also as an Ambassador for the Italian Spinone. His face is recognised as the 'face' of Dogmatic and he has beautifully modelled our Range for his 12 years with great style. He would entertain the crowds at Shows. Crufts and the Trade Shows we attended. thoroughly enjoying meeting and greeting - I'm sure he thought they had come just to see him!

Kofi had the most wonderful, kind and gentle nature, he was an absolute joy to live with, a faithful companion who was at his happiest by your side, seeming to read your every thought. He really was a soulmate and best friend who has been through so much with us, both at home and work. Kofi was by our side both whilst we worked and at home. We had the honour of sharing our lives with such a special, gorgeous boy who had such a big heart and took delight in playing the fool with us and his 'boys', making us laugh and cry.

He has brought us great joy and pride, not only in the Show ring, but also through his beautiful Son and Grand Son and his other progeny. Kofi has always been a wonderful ambassador for the Breed, meeting and greeting people, especially children, as well as dogs with great aplomb. But most of all, a

wonderful, 'one in a million' much loved member of the family.

Everyone who met Kofi knew he was a very special boy and he has been a huge part of our family.

Kofi will continue to be remembered as the 'poster boy' and handsome face of Dogmatic. He was such a handsome boy, with eyes that seemed to go deep into your soul and make your heart ache with the love he brought to you.

Despite coping with health problems in his later years, including an enlarged heart and heart murmur, his problems had become much worse and Kofi quickly became poorly with his latest bout of Aspiration
Pneumonia which causes
persistent coughing and laboured
breathing and he was not
recovering with antibiotics. He was
becoming increasingly wobbly
and signs of Geriatric Onset
Laryngeal Paralysis
Polyneuropathy were worsening so
the dreadful decision was made to
let him sleep in peace.

It was as if Kofi was telling us he had had enough as he struggled down to the bottom of the garden and lay on the grass under the newly planted Indian Bean tree where we had planned to put our past dogs' ashes. He was joined by Archie and Norman who lay either side of him and they seemed to be saying their goodbyes.

We had hoped that having the Vet come to our home to put Kofi to sleep would be a quick, peaceful and dignified end to Kofi's wonderful life, but it was far from that – making for a terribly upsetting time which will continue to haunt us.

Kofi's wonderful Son and Grand Son, Archie and Norman have been absolutely lost without him – as have we – but they will help us to keep Kofi's memory alive and we will help each other through this time.

Kofi leaves a huge void in our lives and we miss him terribly.

Assessment of the DOGMATIC Headcollar for Halifax RSPCA Animal Home.

I have used the Dogmatic in training Holly, a dog for whom I am fostering in an attempt to try and give her the chance of being re-homed after 6 months in kennels. Initially she was a very demanding dog who pulled very strongly when on a lead and was aggressive towards other dogs. To begin with I used a nylon halter on her which she still pulled against and because of the design of this halter it would ride up under her eyes and dig into her muzzle. I have found this a problem with all the other halter types I have used. Some dogs learn not to pull against a halter but others continue to pull against it just as badly as pulling against a lead, the only difference being that the halter allows the owner to have the strength to hold onto the dog in demanding situations. However ideally a halter should be used as an instrumental tool for use in correcting any problems the dog may have but also, just as importantly, be comfortable for the dog to wear. If a dog feels pain around the muzzle when in an excitable or aggressive situation it can become a self perpetuating cycle of associating a particular situation with a painful experience, which would continue to cause anxiety in the dog rather than teaching it to remain calm.

I have been very pleased with the results I have obtained from using the Dogmatic during this Test. I have found that the Dogmatic does not ride up under the dogs eyes – as the strap used for connecting it to the lead is separate from the muzzle strap and therefore pulls the muzzle strap tight but not back. The combination of straps which hold the neck strap to the muzzle strap are very supportive which must give the dog a feeling of security and the neck has a normal buckle and hole combination the same as used in normal leather collars. The strength of the leather helps in keeping the shape of the headcollar which means it is much easier to put on and because of the feeling of firm support the dog seems to accept the headcollar much more easily. The leather is very supple from day one and will improve rather than deteriorate with age and if looked after should last for at least a dog's lifetime. Aesthetically the headcollar is very pleasing to look at and there is a choice of shade (black/brown).

As I am a professional dog walker and behaviourist I know that many people I come into contact with are not satisfied with the present cloth/webbing headcollar designs but have had no alternative choice to date. I think the Dogmatic is a very well thought out design and I will certainly recommend it as my headcollar of preference to both clients and friends and have every intention of purchasing one for my own use in the near future.

Hello, my name is Sophia and I run my own dog training business

"On the Scent" in Great Ashfield, Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk. I am a KCAI Member working towards accreditation and also an Associate Member of the PDTE (Pet dog trainers Europe).

We run classes for puppies as soon as they are fully vaccinated up to the veteran dogs. We also hold beginners/fun agility, gun dogs training workshops, home visits and private lessons. All training is held outdoors at our 10 acre site all year round and feel very blessed to have clients who travel from cambridgeshire, Essex, Norfolk, London as well as my home county Suffolk.

Before we go any further I have to say I am not a huge fan of gadgets, however, they do have their place in dog training and none more than the "Dogmatic" Headcollar which was introduced to me via a client who also happens to be a dog training instructor.

I suffer with back problems and although walking three or four dogs at a time is fine, when one of the younger ones sees a friendly face and gets excited, then my back suffers. My client mentioned during class one day that she had back problems and had invested in the Dogmatic Headcollar which she wanted to use in class. I was hesitant to allow it at first but then after seeing it in action I was rather impressed with it, the way it fitted and the instant result of no pulling from her dog, that I borrowed it for mine!!! I have found that regardless of the breed or cross breed the Dogmatic Headcollar so far, fits perfectly and doesn't ride up like some of the other brands on the market. They also seem to have a calming effect on the dogs, especially those who suffer from dog on dog aggression. They work alongside the training programme NOT instead of the training programme.

Zoë's Mother Susan designed the product due to not being able to help walk the dogs due to having had four back operations and a neck operation. In the time we have been using them the service has been fantastic and all the staff know the products and should one not fit correctly they are more than happy to change it. All my clients who have invested in this product have all been delighted and I certainly have no hesitation in recommending them. (With some strong willed dogs they may need to be introduced over a period of a few days before setting out on a walk).

The Dogmatic Headcollar can be used permanently if wished. As many dogs are, unfortunately, not trained to heel or their owners have disabilities, the Headcollar is ideal to have kind, gentle control of your dog. It is also ideal for strong willed or aggressive dogs and using the Dogmatic gives control and peace of mind. This is far kinder than using neck correction with check chains which can <mark>do so much</mark> damage through being incorrectly fitted and incorrectly used. Sophia



All in all - thanks for a great product at a very reasonable price! And fast overseas shipping too!



Equipment review Featured in Dog Training News

'I arrived at the RSPCA in Birmingham armed with my latest piece of training equipment under arm, and upon entering reception was met with curious glances of my peers. What was this curious contraption? I handed it around for inspection, declaring proudly it's purpose; to gain complete control of our black beauty, Cara.

In case you missed last month's edition of DTN, Cara, while completely delightful in every other aspect, is a dog-walker's nightmare charge. Her favoured past-times are causing back injuries in kennel staff, swallowing anything that can be shredded down to fit in her mouth and bouncing around like a hyperactive kangeroo. Seemingly oblivious to the path of destruction she leaves in her wake, kennel staff are concerned that when she leaves for her new home, Cara won't get the exercise she needs simply because her family will be put off from taking her out!

'That will stop her? I'll believe it when I see it.' I was told.

I set off to meet my fuzzy friend, stopping only to ask for some assistance in holding her still so that I could get the equipment on her. When we arrived at the run, Cara was jumping up the walls, obviously eager to come out and play; although I think she was less pleased about the whole thing when I produced the Dogmatic. Looking something like a horse's headcollar, the Dogmatic is made to last. Made from thick leather, the muzzle piece slips over the dog's nose and the neck strap is fastened by a buckle, adjustable to suit your dog's face. You attach the lead to the ring that runs through a nylon * band connected beneath the nose piece; the nylon * applies pressure to the dog's face any time the lead tightens, causing the dog to want to keep the lead slack and so nicely walk to heel.

Cara needed some gentle persuasion to get the Dogmatic on, but once there she spent a few moments pawing at it before following my lead through the gate. The change in her behaviour was instant and dramatic. She pulled the lead taut once and it slackened immediately, Cara walking meekly at my side as though we had been practising for years.

Once we were in the paddock, Cara continued to walk nicely with me, despite her obvious longing to be bounding in front. There was not a single tug, strain or accidental toppling of dog walker, which was certainly a huge step forward. We stopped once or twice as Cara attempted to remove the device with her paws, but considering this was the first time she had ever worn anything like this, her reaction was very mild.

The Dogmatic fitted very comfortably on Cara's face and there was no soreness from rubbing or chafing. It is important, as with any training apparatus, that you get equipment the right size for your dog, Dogmatic have an excellent reputation for customer care and are happy to discuss your individual needs when you're considering a purchase. From a purely cosmetic point of view, the Dogmatic is possibly one of the nicest and most expensive-looking pieces of training gear you will find on the market, particularly when matched up with a quality leather lead. Even the most fashion conscious canine would be happy about wearing this one.

The Dogmatic eliminated Cara's pulling completely, having almost a calming influence on the dog as she walked on a loose lead. While the angelic state lasted only as long as the headcollar was on, it served its purpose in making walking a pleasure rather than a chore, and when applied with appropriate training, I believe the dog could make a transition from walking properly on the headcollar to walking properly on the lead alone.

Defeated, Cara sat down and allowed me to fuss her, unsure whether to try and bounce up or remain with four paws down. If dogs could give dirty looks, I think Cara would have shot me one then.

We would like to thank Dogmatic for generously donating a headcollar to the RSPCA for use on Cara.

Since the piece was written, Cara has been rehomed with someone who has shown real willingness to put the time and effort into the training she desperately needs.'

Just wanted to say how wonderful the Dogmatic is, I can now enjoy lovely walks with my Mals and Sibes due to your wonder lead and headcollar, after being involved in a series of road accidents I was rendered bed ridden for over 18 months and incapacitated for a further 2yrs, as my Mals and Sibes grew so did their strength and walking my one girl had become a nightmare, I really dreaded the thought of taking her out as she pulled like a freight train but when you actually stopped and watched her she was hardly pulling at all but given the breed she was doing what came naturally to her, our walks had become irate and frustrating her pulling often aggravated my back injury and it got to the point only my other half could actually walk her and sometimes he became frustrated with her pulling. Thanks to your wonderful Dogmatic our walks with our girl are now most relaxed and I actually look forward to our walks and our time out together.

After getting a male Malamute the Dogmatic lead and collar has proved to be a real god send in his obedience training especially his teenage stages as he would use his brute strength to pull and drag me about when he was having a defiant stage. Often I would feel like I had done ten rounds with Mike Tyson after an hour's training session then I wouldn't be able to train the next week as my back would hurt so much, with Dogmatic I'm always in control at training and me and my boy have come on with his training in leaps and bounds and he now loves his training nights and so do I.

I tried not to tighten the leash when I spotted a dog coming, when you have a breed of dog like mine you have no choice given they can pull 8 times their own body weight, if I'd have kept her on a loose leash she would have me over in a flash if she decided she really wanted to be confrontational with another dog so my stress and panic was being sent down the lead to her, now thanks to Dogmatic I am able to keep the lead loose while having more control than I ever had using only a standard neck type collar, now I'm calmer and I am confident I have full control which transmits to my girl so she is calmer and I'm happy to say she doesn't have many embarrassing moments any more.

About a month ago I found your website by total luck and I was desperate. Max had pulled me over and dragged me round a corner when all I was doing was holding his lead!





General Information fitting guide







The Dogmatic should fit snugly around the dog's face and behind the ears. The noseband is placed over the dog's nose, with the loop under the dog's chin. Fasten the buckle (in the Leather range) or adjust the straps on the neck strap and fasten clasp (with the Padded Cushioned Webbing range) so as to get maximum two fingers underneath. Attach the lead to the ring on the loop under the chin and then commence walking/training.


The Dogmatic should not move about the face, go towards the eye or ride up at all once the lead is attached and however much your dog pulls. If this seems to be the case, it indicates that the sizing is too big so please try an alternative size. With the correct sizing and fitting, your dog should not be able to remove the Dogmatic, but should you so wish, the Dogmatic can be used in conjunction with a Training Lead, with one hook being attached to the Dogmatic and the other to your dog's collar.


Please do not attach the same hook to both collar and Dogmatic or use other makes' links as this will prevent the Dogmatic being used to it's full potential. If you are concerned, we would recommend using a Training Lead (with two hooks) and attach one hook to the collar and the other hook to the Dogmatic. That way, you can hold the lead and still work using the Dogmatic but the collar is attached independently for your peace of mind.
